Activities

All of our objectives in 2023 have not been achieved for various reasons.

However, three information sessions on the importance of space sciences were organized for the benefit of students at the end of their undergraduate studies at the National University of Sciences, Engineering Technologies and Mathematics.

In the program of a research master's degree which will begin in 2014 at the Faculty of Science and Technology of Natitingou, we have managed to insert a few modules relating to space physics.

Outlook

Benin is one of the African countries that does not have a minimum of measuring devices. This is one of the problems that slows down our efforts to convince students to invest in space science studies.

In 2024, we plan to discuss with ISWI coordinators from neighboring countries which have an observatories to see the possibility of sending our students for short immersion stays.

Student ONAH Waidi will finalize the writing of his dissertation to support his doctoral thesis before the end of the first semester of this year.

Two of our students will also participate in the space meteorology school which will be held this year in Guinea.
