

How to reach the venue?

From Palakkad side: Take Palakkad-Ernakulam highway, get down at Pattikkad junction and check with Highway Palace Inn Hotel about accommodation for 20th and 21st Undergraduate Mathematics Training Camps (UG Camps) of the Centre for Mathematical and Statistical Sciences (CMSS). Highway Palace Inn is on your left side.

From Kanyakumari side: Take bus/train/car to Trichur. From Sakthan bus stand take a bus to Peechi dam (almost every 10 minutes intervals), get down at Pattikkad junction and enquire at Highway Palace Inn Hotel about accommodation for the UG Camps of CMSS. If you are driving then continue on the highway to Palakkad-Coimbatore side, pass Mannuthy and stop at Pattikkad junction. Highway Palace Inn is on your right side.

From Kasaragod side: Take bus/train/car to Trichur Sakthan bus stand. Take a bus to Peechi dam and get down at Pattikkad junction. Highway Palace Inn Hotel is on your right side. If you are driving then from Trichur turn to Mannuthy-Palakkad side and stop at Pattikkad junction.

Coming by air: Take a flight to Kochi international airport. Take a prepaid taxi to Pattikkad (Peechi dam area in Trichur District), stop at Pattikkad junction and enquire at Highway Palace Inn Hotel on your right side.
