


Fig1: LPDA antenna at SANSA in transit meridian. Fig. 2: Callisto, PC and cabling at SANSA

- Very bad news about our colleague Dr. Ayman Mahrous from SWMC at the American University in Helwan/Cairo, Egypt. He was shot a couple days ago during a peaceful march in Egypt. He is recovering and we wish him all the best.
- Triest/Italy is back online with an instrument attached to a commercial LPDA. Their nice 10m parabolic dish is broken and cannot be used at the moment.
- A Callisto spectrometer has recently been delivered to University of Ethiopia. Unfortunately neither the antenna nor the spectrometer went through customs in Addis Ababa yet.
- Mongolian Research Center for Astronomy and Geophysics (RCAG) has again set into operation their two Callisto spectrometers.
- CALLISTO or Callisto denotes to the spectrometer itself while e-Callisto denotes to the worldwide network.
- Callisto data are hosted at Fachhochschule Nordwestschweiz (University of applied sciences FHNW) in Brugg/Windisch, Switzerland. Process control, user communication and scripts are maintained at Institute for Astronomy of ETH Zurich.
